FLYING TO PELION

the following airports serve the pelion area:

thessaloniki

www.thessalonikiairport.com

from thessaloniki airport there is a bus into thessaloniki bus terminal (about 40 mins) where you can connect with a bus to volos (about 3 hrs) and then a bus to tsangarada (about 1.5 hrs). timetables and information for the ktel buses are available at ktelmacedonia.gr/en/content.

there is also a train service where you need to change at Larissa to go on to volos ~ this takes much longer than the bus or driving.

there are also many car hire companies at thessaloniki airport. it is approximately 300 km drive from thessaloniki to tsangarada.

athens

from athens airport there is also a bus service to the bus terminal and then an onward bus to volos and tsangarada. it is about one hour longer journey from athens by bus or car than volos. timetables and information for the ktel buses are available at ktelmacedonia.gr/en/content. there is also a train service, again longer travelling time.

there are many car hire companies serving the airport. it is approximately 400 km drive from athens to tsangarada.

volos

volos is the closest airport, only an hour or so away from tsangarada. however the airport is only open from mid-may to early-october.

there is a transfer bus into volos bus terminal where you can connect with a bus to tsangarada.

car hire should be arranged ahead of travelling so that a car can be brought to the airport for your arrival.

skiathos

skiathos airport is also only open from may to october. from here you can take the "flying dolphin" speed boat to reach agios ioannis (about 1.5 hours boat trip). driving from agios ioannis to tsangarada takes about 20 minutes
